Full-Time Residential Care

Those living with us on a full-time basis experience excellent personal residential care provided by experienced, highly trained staff in a serene, safe, warm and comfortable environment of a pleasant "Home away from home".

Dementia Care

We understand that while the environment plays a big part for all residents, it makes an even greater impact on those with Dementia:

- Each person who works here is trained on how to best help and support someone whose life has been irreversibly changed by dementia;
- With our colourful environment, special adaptations and targeted activities to trigger reminiscing and fond memories, we want all our residents to enjoy their time at the Home.

Respite Care

The purpose of respite care is to provide temporary relief to caregivers in the Home. Respite services are available to support an individual's ability to live longer in the community by ensuring families are also supported.

Day Care

The purpose of daycare is to provide temporary relief to caregivers in the home between 10 am-4 p.m. for 7 days a week and over bank holidays. This service can include providing food and activities to the residents and any other needs that the residents may require.

Continuing Health Care

Please note that we are also able to take residents who have Continuing Health Care (CHC) needs as long as our manager can assess that their needs can be met once assessed.

SECURITY & SERENITY:

As such, we will respond to our residents needs for security by providing a serene and safe environment, where skilled help is readily available to any person who lives with us, to achieve their optimum state of health and well-being;

Individual requirement for privacy will be respected at all times and all information relating to individuals will be treated in a confidential manner;

We will regularly carry out risk assessments of the Home, the equipment we use and the resident activities amongst others to ensure a safe environment;

We will also have a rigorous system in place for checking the background of new staff to ensure that anyone joining us is appropriately checked and qualified to do so.
